**Vehicle update** The committee has not yet met. Boone County High School does not want to sell their truck. There is another trailer and semi that is being looked at. The cost of a driver with a truck is (per trip; 70 miles or less) would be \$750.00 minimum. Emergencies could come up with these drivers that could make them unavailable for a given day. Price ranges on trailers on the internet is \$5000-12000, inspected and road-ready. Discussion took place in regard to necessity of making this purchase at this time in light of other financial concerns that exist.
