- Fundraising report: Cherie Shields reports that the next Beef's night is Dec 19th.

 - Tri Fold Fundraiser: We paid \$3000.00 for the cards and we have only made 1670.00 in profit. WE still have over 760 tri folds to sell. Please sell the cards and return the money ASAP. We realize the cards are tough to sell----but if we sell all the cards---we will make over 10,000. That would be great. We talked about setting up outside local businesses to sell the cards. Any volunteers would be appreciated.
 - Football concessions earned over 6000.00. Basketball concessions now begin. The first basketball game is November 29th. We will need at least 4 people at each basketball game. The next game is November 30th, then Dec 3, Dec. 6, Dec. 7, Dec 8, Dec 13, Dec 15, Jan 3 and Jan 5th. We will be sending info out about sign up through CHARMS. The games are much warmer than football and much easier. It is a good way to get some volunteer time.
 - Slides should arrive this week. We made over 900.00 profit on the slides.
 - RTB concessions made over 2500.00
 - Amish is due by November 15th.
- RTB Report: the total profit for the day was 1600.00. The judges expense alone was over 5000.00 and that expense took most of profit. We had many small bands that do not bring many fans—therefore a low handle at the gate. We hope to improve the competition in the future to make it more profitable.
 - Denise Sparks provided copies to the budget. Our marching band account at Ryle has been depleted and we will be transferring money to cover Marching band expenses. We also have a General Band fund that has money in it to cover many of the expenses that are not covered by fees collections.
 - Winterguard completion has been slated for March 24th and March 31st. We have facility approval for the March 24th----but Tim and Lori are meeting with Mr. Turner about the March 31st weekend. The 31st weekend is the larger of the two weekends and hopefully we will reach an agreement.
 - Band banquet is being planned by Martha Kirby. We will attempt to schedule at Ryle on an acceptable date---then we will look off site if a date cannot be

found. If anyone has access to a location where the banquet can be held--- please contact Martha Kirby.
