General Financial Update:

- RTOB financial statement offered
 - Still waiting on finalization of profit, as we are still waiting on payment from an advertiser and we haven't received the custodian bill from the school, yet
- With regard to the overall budget, we are still ahead of where we were this time last year, though the positive will wane throughout the calendar year as we receive and pay outstanding staffing bills

Fundraising Endeavors:

- Bingo Update offered by Ryan Royse
 - Bingo beginning again in November
 - We remain in consistent need of volunteers
 - We will be running discounted computer packages from time to time in order to increase sales/upsell
- Lee Coates discussed the 3C sale
 - We are currently at 50% of our sales goal despite only 40 kids submitting their forms thus far. Forms are due in two days.
- Chick Fil A Update:
 - Calendars were picked up today; will be given to the kids on Friday for distribution
 - Still have about 100 calendars that we can sell
 - CFA has invited the senior class for a free dinner on 11/1 or 11/8;
 - We will be doing both dates as CFA can only accommodate 25 kids per night.
